1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 Arts Education:

In the 2024-25 school year, Clay Joint Elementary School launched a brand new visual arts instruction program for all students in grades K-5. Funding from the Prop 28 Arts grant allowed for the extension of an instructional aide's hours, enabling her to deliver dedicated visual arts lessons to each grade throughout the school year. Additionally, the grant supported the acquisition of a comprehensive, standards-based arts curriculum and a wide range of art supplies to facilitate engaging, hands-on learning experiences. A laminator was also purchased to preserve and display student artwork. Through this program, students received instruction in fundamental art concepts, techniques, and art history, while expressing their creativity through a variety of mediums.
